It can also describe a general state of weakness, uncertainty, or vulnerability, whether physical, emotional, or in a broader context like the fragility of an ecosystem, or environment.'

## Terms and Conditions

1. By submitting an entry the artist agrees to abide by all terms and conditions. The submitting artist must be a resident of Tasmania.
2. Submissions will be received from **Sept 1<sup>st</sup> 2025**  
Closing of submissions: **January 9<sup>th</sup> 2026**  
**Delivery:** Saturday Feb 14th and Sunday Feb 15th 10am-3pm  
**Collection** of unsold works Sunday March 15th 10-3pm
3. All work must be for sale. 10% commission will be charged on any sale made.
4. No responsibility but all care will be taken with exhibiting work. Insurance is the responsibility of the artist.
5. The artwork must be an original, unaided work by the artist.
6. No artwork will be accepted if it is deemed offensive.
7. All stretched canvas and framed work must be professionally presented and ready to hang, with D rings, 1/3 of the way down.
8. All work must be delivered to the gallery strictly within the hours stated above.
9. Work cannot be removed before the end of the exhibition.
10. The artist grants permission to WASS to use a photo of their artwork for publicity and promotional purposes.

Artwork to have been completed in the last 12 months, and not previously exhibited on the North West Coast.

Entrants must submit a crisp and sharp image of the artwork with an artist's statement of no more than 50 words and emailed to [mountrolandartprize@gmail.com](mailto:mountrolandartprize@gmail.com) by January 9th 2026.

No late entries accepted.

A judging panel will select short-listed artists by assessing the online image and statement provided.

The decision of the panel will be final.

Successful entrants will be notified by January 23rd 2026.

2D artwork to be no larger than 1m x 1m, including frame.

Freestanding sculpture to have a base no larger than 35cm x 35cm, and 1m high, and a maximum of 10kg in weight. Please submit 2 views of the sculpture.

### Correct labelling of your work:

Title, artist's name, phone no, price, medium must be clearly printed on the form and label provided, attached to the back of the artwork.
